It offers authors and organizers versatile and highly flexible publishing solutions, which aim to make conference proceedings widely usable by the scientific community.

Aims and Scope

MATEC Web of Conferences focuses on the publishing of conference proceedings dealing with all fundamental and applied research aspects in the areas Materials science, Engineering and Chemistry. Proceedings are published under the scientific responsibility of the conference organizers.

MATEC Web of Conferences aims to increase the visibility and enhance the profile of the scientific events, as well as to highlight the work of the contributors. It provides a safe long-term open-access record of the conferences in order to make the proceedings citable and widely usable by the scientific community. Its services are fast, affordable and suitable to large international conferences as well as small workshops and meetings.

Benefits are:

- **Open access:** all documents will be free to read and download.
- **Copyright policy:** the copyright of the articles will be retained by the author(s) under the Creative Commons Attribution license, which permits unrestricted use, distribution, and reproduction in any medium, provided the original work is properly cited.
- **Immediate citability:** every document will be identified, like any journal article, by authorship, title, and all relevant metadata for indexing and abstracting, e.g. like a DOI enabling the cross-referencing.
- **Fast publication:** the documents will be available online within three months of us receiving the contributions.
- **High visibility:** all documents will be indexed in main databases (Google Scholar, CAS, Compendex, Inspec, DOAJ, Web of Science, Scopus). They will become integral parts of the technical literature and will be easily found online.
- **Additional publishing options:** Organizers can select from a range of services: online-only, online and printed, or online and CD /DVD, plus a range of editing levels.
- **Articles metrics:** *MATEC Web of Conferences* provides authors and readers with a set of services and indicators, to promote the dissemination of scientific information and to assess the impact of the articles: search engine, e-mail alerts, related articles, citation data, page views...
- **Conference promotion:** as part of the proceedings arrangements, EDP Sciences and Web of Conferences can provide promotion services for the event.

Publishing rates

Basic online publication

The organizers provide **print-ready PDF** articles realized from *MATEC Web of Conferences* templates, properly generated, named and submitted as indicated in the guidelines of the journal.

The basic online publication includes:

- ✓ Preparation of the online metadata (title, authors, affiliations, abstract, references),
- ✓ Attribution of DOI Names and indexation to CrossRef®,
- ✓ Online publication of the PDF articles and creation of HTML metadata at the website of *MATEC Web of Conferences*,
- ✓ All online articles are published in colours,
- ✓ Indexation in main databases: Google Scholar, CAS, Compendex, Inspec, DOAJ, CPCI (Web of Science), Scopus.
- ✓ Access to journal's services (recommend this article, download citation, metrics, citation tracking...) and links to social bookmarking websites,
- ✓ Archiving and maintenance for an unlimited time.

⇒ **40 € per article (before taxes) for a total of articles between 61 and 70 articles**

Additional charges

After receiving the articles, EDP Sciences will check the quality of the PDFs. If problems are detected, EDP Sciences will contact the organizers in order to propose them to submit a new version of the problematic articles. At this stage, each new version of an article will be charged 15 €.

+ 15 € per new version of an article, before the online publishing of the article

Once a paper has been published online, changes are only permitted in cases of serious scientific error. In those cases, an erratum or a note is published according to the practices of professional scientific publishing. The publication of errata, notes, new version of an article, as well as an additional article, will be charged 100 euros if the error is on the part of the conference organizers. It will not be charged if the error is on the part of EDP Sciences.

+ 100 € per new publication, after the online publishing of the proceedings

Taxes Guidelines

Customers within the European Union will be charged VAT (20%), unless *MATEC Web of Conferences* is provided with a valid VAT number.

Customers outside the European Union won't be charged VAT.

Publication procedure

- ✓ After having discussed and agreed costs, we sign a “Publishing Agreement” in order to plan the publication;
- ✓ The organizers of the conference should provide the authors with the [instructions for authors](#) and the [license agreement](#);
- ✓ The authors submit their document to the organizers of the conference, who conduct peer review according the [Policy on Publishing Integrity](#). Accepted papers are supplied to the journal by the organizers, as indicated in the [Guidelines for organizers](#).
- ✓ A final quote is sent after we receive all the documents, and the invoice is established in accordance with the final number of articles and pages to be published.
- ✓ We process all the documents without delay.
- ✓ The organizers will be supplied with PDF proofs of the cover or CD label, but not of the articles. So it is important that authors and organizers ensure papers have been adequately checked and proofed prior to submission.
