CLOSING

5.1 Conclusion

It's crucial for teenagers to understand national history, particularly local struggles like the Battle of November 10th in Surabaya. By learning about heroes like Major General Sungkono, teenagers can foster a love for their country and increase their awareness of national defense in their daily lives.

Utilizing engaging and technologically advanced learning media, such as digital comics, can increase the effectiveness of conveying historical and national values contextually and in line with youth interests. With concrete support in the form of policies and facilities for the development of creative learning media, this can strengthen character education and expand the reach of historical information dissemination to the younger generation, particularly through easily accessible digital platforms.

This design is expected to serve as a reference in developing other forms of educational media tailored to the interests and needs of adolescents. The focus on an interactive and narrative approach is expected to increase the effectiveness of conveying historical messages and national values to the nation's future generations.
