

CHAPTER V CONCLUSION

5.1 Conclusion

The design of this LPQ ARLI illustrated book on tajwid instruction was motivated by the need for teaching materials that are more engaging and easier for children aged 7–9 to understand. Based on observations, interviews, and questionnaires, it was found that children tend to struggle with understanding tajwid material because the presentation of the material is still text-heavy and lacks visual aids suited to children’s learning styles. Additionally, children are more interested in learning presented through stories, illustrations, and interactive activities.

Through this project, an illustrated tajwid learning book titled *The Secrets of the Tajwid Planet* was produced, combining basic tajwid material with an adventure story and imaginative illustrations. The material is presented concisely and progressively to make it easier for children to understand. The book also includes educational videos accessible via QR codes on each lesson to help children directly see and hear examples of correct pronunciation.

The visual concept is based on the keywords “Concise and Imaginative,” so the book’s overall design is simple yet engaging and capable of stimulating children’s imagination. With this design, it is hoped that the book can serve as a more enjoyable alternative learning medium for tajwid, help increase children’s interest in learning, and simplify the tajwid learning process at LPQ ARLI.

5.2 Recommendations

The design of this illustrated book on tajwid instruction can still be further developed, both in terms of content and supporting media. Future research could include more comprehensive tajwid content, expand the forms of learning interactivity, or develop the media into digital and animated formats to make the learning experience more varied. Additionally, further testing is needed to assess the book’s effectiveness in directly improving children’s ability to read the Qur’an over a specific period of time. This would serve as a follow-up step to strengthen children’s learning experience in a fun and sustainable way.
